

JOB DESCRIPTION FOR ASSOCIATE CAMPUS MINISTER TO MEN

The Associate Campus Minister to Men will be a single or married man of spiritual integrity and maturity whose primary responsibility will be ministry to men involved in the Campus Christian Fellowship ministry. He will report to the Senior Campus Minister and his responsibilities will include:

***Developing & Implementing Men-Specific Ministries**

- assist in providing supervision and guidance to male student interns
- assist in overseeing Bible studies, retreats and other special events
- disciple and counsel students
- train and develop student leaders
- contact prospective students

***Involvement in Overall Ministry of Campus Christian Fellowship**

- assist in planning overall direction of CCF ministry
- participate in large group meetings
- participate in retreats and other special CCF events, including mission trips
- participate in weekly staff meetings
- participate in quarterly Board meetings
- use spiritual gifts and abilities in appropriate areas as needed

***Administration**

- spend time raising needed financial support
- maintain regular contact with financial supporters
- participate with other staff leadership in outreach teams to local churches
- submit written report for quarterly Board meetings
- submit budget requests for annual budget proposals
- assist Senior Campus Minister with administrative duties as necessary

***Personal Ministry**

- be an active participant in a biblically-based church (when not traveling for CCF)
- have regular devotional and study time
