Overview

Campus Minister for the Women's Ministry is responsible for developing and fostering a community of all college students with an emphasis placed on the women. Develop and implements strategies and programs that facilitate spiritual development of the female students involved with the CSF and UT women in general, working cooperatively with other ministerial staff. Reports directly to the Lead Campus Minister/Director.

Specific Responsibilities and Expectations:

A. Spiritual Development

- Work with the Lead Campus Minister to develop and implement strategies that encourage spiritual growth, maturity, and outreach among women involved at the CSF.
- Foster relationships with female students.
- Engaging in one-to-one evangelism/discipleship with women.
- Coordinating special events for women.
- Work with staff to develop and implement Core Group opportunities.
- Encourage growth through study of God's word, prayer, service projects and worship experiences.

B. Support Team Development

- Develop and maintain a financial support team that will help fund salary. The Lead Campus Minister/Director will give guidelines as to goals for the development of a support team. This will include maintaining regular contact with and scheduling engagements, travel, and presentations to existing and potential supporters.

C. Administration

- Provide a minister's report at board meeting.
- Communicate regular contact with students and supporters.
